**Lac du Flambeau Tribal Scholarship Program**  
**Application 2023-2024**

In its continuing commitment to guiding and supporting the Lac du Flambeau community on its lifelong path to success, the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians is pleased to announce its second annual scholarship program for graduating high school students.

**Eligibility Requirements**

To be eligible for a scholarship, students are required to meet the following criteria:

- ✚ Be an enrolled Lac du Flambeau tribal member
- ✚ Be a high school graduate during the 2023-2024 academic year
- ✚ Attending college full-time beginning the 2024-2025 academic year
- ✚ Have a complete Lac du Flambeau Tribal Scholarship Program Application and required documentation on file by the **April 30, 2024 deadline**.

**Required Documentation**

To be considered for a scholarship, students are required to submit the following documentation by the designated deadline:

- ✚ Verification of tribal enrollment (copy of Tribal ID, Certificate of Enrollment, etc.)
- ✚ Lac du Flambeau Tribal Scholarship Program Application
- ✚ Copy of a current high school transcript (official or unofficial).



## **Scholarships and Award Amounts**

The Lac du Flambeau Tribe will award ten (10) \$1,000.00 scholarships for the 2024-2025 academic year. Two of each of the following scholarships are available:

### **7 Grandfather Teachings Scholarship**

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed holistically. In addition to the Scholarship Application and essay, the 7 Grandfather Teachings Scholarship requires a separate essay pertaining to the 7 Grandfather Teachings.

### **Leadership Scholarship**

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed holistically. In addition to the Scholarship Application and essay, the Leadership Scholarship requires a separate essay pertaining to leadership.

### **Vocational Scholarship**

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed holistically. In addition to the Scholarship Application and essay, the Vocational Scholarship requires a separate essay pertaining to the student's pursuit of a vocational program. To be eligible for the Vocational Scholarship, students are required to be enrolled in a vocational program beginning the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters.

### **Technical Scholarship**

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed holistically. In addition to the Scholarship Application and essay, the Technical Scholarship requires a separate essay pertaining to the student's enrollment at a technical college or institution. To be eligible for the Technical Scholarship, students are required to be enrolled in a technical college or institution beginning the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters.

### **University Scholarship**

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed holistically. In addition to the Scholarship Application and essay, the University Scholarship requires a separate essay pertaining to the student's enrollment at a university. To be eligible for the University Scholarship, students are required to be enrolled in a university beginning the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters.



Scholarships may be applied towards tuition, related fees, textbooks and on-campus housing expenses only. Scholarships will be awarded directly to the student's college or institution on the student's behalf.

Scholarships will be awarded during the standard academic Fall and Spring semesters; students will receive a \$500.00 scholarship during the Fall 2024 semester and a \$500.00 scholarship during the Spring 2025 semester, provided all required documentation is on file by the deadline. In the event that the selected scholarship recipient does not provide the required documentation by the deadline, the student will be ineligible to receive a scholarship and an alternate recipient will be awarded. In the event that the selected scholarship recipient no longer meets the eligibility criteria for the scholarship after they have been selected, the student will be ineligible to receive a scholarship and an alternate recipient will be awarded.

### **Application Process**

The deadline to submit a complete Lac du Flambeau Tribal Scholarship Program Application and required documentation is **Friday, April 30, 2024**. Applications may be mailed or delivered in person. E-mail and fax submissions will also be accepted upon request. Please submit complete applications to:

Applications must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2024. Late and incomplete scholarship applications are ineligible to be considered for any scholarship(s) after the deadline.

Letters regarding the status of a student's scholarship application will be mailed no later than June 15, 2024.
