**NOTE:** The district will not be responsible for any damages to snowmobiles on school property.

## ALL STUDENTS OPERATING SNOWMOBILES AT LUHS MUST ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- 1. All snowmobiles arriving and departing from school property must follow designated trail routes and only park in the approved area. The trail follows along the McDonald's fence with the parking area just outside the Memorial Garden Area.
- 2. Anyone operating a snowmobile on school grounds must observe the maximum 10 M.P.H. speed limit and may not use the roads, walkways, or any part of the parking lot.
- 3. When crossing any road, the snowmobiler must yield to all vehicle and pedestrian traffic.
- 4. The snowmobile will be parked in the approved area by 8:10 a.m. and will remain parked until 3:30 p.m. You must obtain permission from the high school office to go to the snowmobile during school hours; this includes lunch and study halls.
- 5. Storage of helmets, boots, and other clothing is your responsibility.
- 6. Any snowmobiler violating any Town of Minocqua Ordinance or DNR violation shall be subject to prosecution.
- 7. If the fence around the Memorial Garden falls down or becomes damaged, please report it immediately to a staff member. Also, use caution around the Memorial Garden.
- 8. Violation of any of the above rules will result in the loss of parking privileges and/or disciplinary measures as outlined in the school discipline policies.
